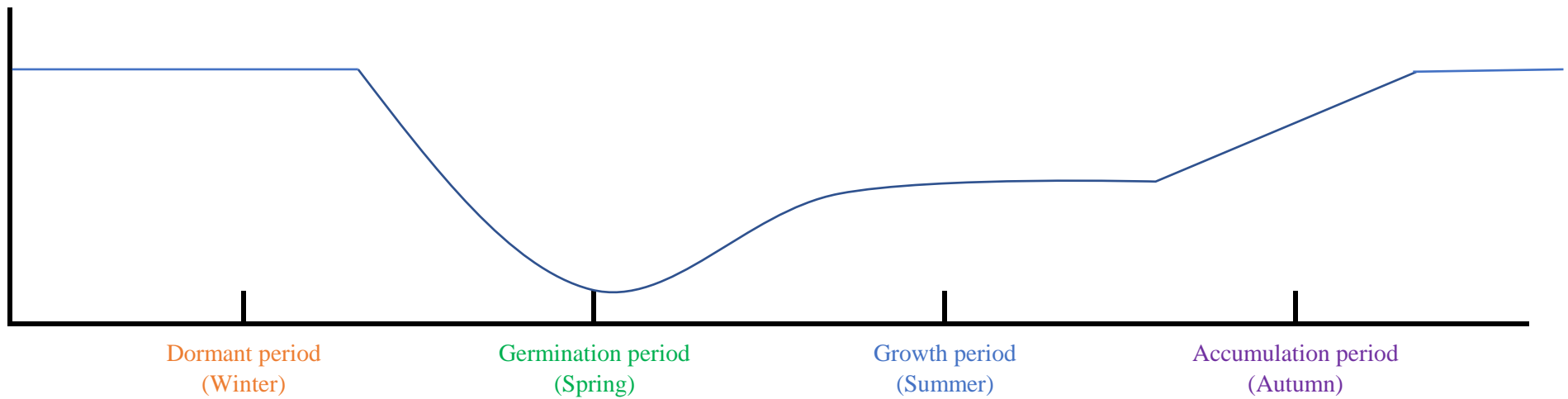


Nutrient consumption and production change depending on the season



Since it does not grow (does not consume accumulated nutrients), it has the highest nutrient concentration. The higher the concentration, the more it can expect to make the best tea for next spring.

Consume accumulated nutrients and increase growth. The nutrient concentration drops once. If it sprinkles putrefactive liquid fertilizer in this timing, tea taste will be bitter than as usual.

It does not accumulate because it grows vigorously. Putrefactive liquid fertilizer is sprinkled on the surface of the earth to replace bases so that fertilizer components can be absorbed efficiently. Fish soribble is also sprayed on the foliage to increase the photosynthetic capacity of the leaves.

The growth slows down and the concentration increases again. Consumption decreases and accumulated components increase. It is best to have abundant autumn buds and self-pinching.
